

## I work as a contractor, now what?

You are employed as a contractor, or you employ employees who are considered contractors. Then it is important that you make good agreements with the client about employment at the time of the corona crisis.

## Step-by-step plan:

- 1. Please contact the client in advance.
- 2. Ask about the measures regarding corona. A non-exhaustive list can be found below.
- Make concrete agreements with the client about who will implement which measures.
- Discuss the concrete agreements with your own employees. If the client (or one of the client's employees) does not comply with the measures, then agree with his/her employees that they may stop work at any time and contact the employer to discuss the situation.

What measures have been taken regarding a welcome procedure?		
<ul> <li>Has the welcome procedure been adapted?</li> <li>Is there an applicable contact person to provide the employee with guidance?</li> <li>Must the time of visit be announced in advance?</li> <li>Where should the employee present him/herself?</li> <li>What is the shortest way to travel through the company to get to the site to carry out the activity?</li> <li>What measures are being taken to address the securing of social distancing?</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Markings, protective barriers, signage?</li> <li>Specific handling rules?</li> <li>Doors, passageways, etc.?</li> <li>Has the use of lifts been adapted?</li> <li>Has the arrangement for the use of social facilities (changing rooms, canteen, etc.) been adapted (if applicable)</li> <li>Adapted waste processing? What should we do with waste?</li> <li>How is transport of waste on the company site organised (if distances are too great on foot)?</li> </ul>		
Does the contractor's employee have the option to wash his/her hands or to disinfect them with alcohol gel?		
What measures have been taken regarding the workshop and maintenance?		
- What measures have been taken to prevent contamination via materials (cleaning workpieces, work equipment, control panels, etc.) before the contractor can start work?		
<ul> <li>Are the rooms where people work sufficiently ventilated?</li> <li>Are essential physical meetings limited in time and in the number of participants? Do these take place in a cleaned and ventilated room? Is there sufficient room for social distancing to be guaranteed?</li> </ul>
