

Who should not (yet) be vaccinated?

To achieve herd immunity, 70 to 80% of the population must be vaccinated. You can contribute as well.

As a precaution, **specific groups are currently excluded from vaccination:**

- ✓ Children under 18 years of age
- ✓ Pregnant women*
- ✓ People with a fever and symptoms that may indicate an acute infection
- ✓ People who have recently tested positive for corona and have not yet been symptom-free for 14 days
- ✓ People with a history of severe allergic reactions

*Women who wish to have children should postpone pregnancy until at least two months after the last dose of the vaccine.

*An individual exception is possible in case of increased risk (high risk of exposure and/or risk patient) and with a medical certificate from the attending physician.

- ⚠ **Reduced immune response** to vaccine is possible for immunocompromised individuals including those receiving immunosuppressive therapy
