Travelling safely in the winter



- Prepare your vehicle for the winter
- Ompletely **defrost** your windscreen
- Never make sudden manoeuvres
- Adjust your speed and keep your distance
- Check the weather report before you leave
- Park your car under cover when possible



- Check your bicycle
- Make sure you are visible in traffic
- Make sure you have the right equipment
- Park your bicycle in a covered bicycle shed when possible
- Always wear a bicycle helmet

Riding a **moped**?
Opt for a full-face helmet to a jet helmet.



- Double check whether the bus/train is running
- Wear warm clothing
- Sit down or **hold on tight** to a handlebar or safety bar
- Request your stop in good time so the driver does not have to brake abruptly
- Watch out for other road users when getting off the bus



- Wear sturdy shoes with extra grip
- Watch out for slippery spots
- Walk with splayed feet (like a penguin)
- Make sure you are visible in traffic
- Remove ice and snow from access paths

General tips for all road users



- ✓ Leave on time
- Be considerate to other road users.
- Dress warm. A thick coat also reduces the chance of injuries or hurting yourself if you should fall
- ✓ Make yourself visible when it is dark
