How can you stay safe?



- Do not stack tables and chairs in places where they will hinder passageways.
- Clean up **spilled liquids** immediately to avoid slippery surfaces.
- Wear the appropriate clothing in the kitchen to protect you from hot liquid splashes.
- Put on gloves when your are cleaning up broken glass.

Ergonomics is the best policy

- Heavy job ahead? Use tools (such as a hand truck) or ask for help.
- O Hold serving trays as close as possible to your body and support them with your forearm and flat hand.

3 Danger, high voltage!

- Only work with **equipment** that is in good condition. Report **defects** immediately.
- Never touch sockets, switches or electrical appliances with wet hands.
- Roll out extension cables completely to prevent overheating.
- Always switch electrical appliances off after use and unplug them.
- Never open fuse boxes.

Look after your health above all else

- What do you do in the event of an accident? Have somebody to look at it, and inform your supervisor.
- If you come into contact with food, thorough hand hygiene is crucial.
- **○** Use **hearing protection** if you have to work in a **loud environment**.

5 Don't play with fire

- ⊗ Be careful with everything associated with fire and flames.
- Inform yourself about the evacuation route and assembly point in the event of a fire.

- Tell your supervisor if you are feeling stressed.
